ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Veteran with a discharge under honorable conditions from U.S. Armed Forces or the Pennsylvania Military Forces. Also spouse or surviving spouse of an eligible veteran. Resident of Pennsylvania.

APPLICATION PROCESS

May obtain applications from County Director of Veteran's Affairs, Service Officer of established veterans organizations, Social Service Dept. of Veterans Affairs Medical Center, Social Service Dept. of the PA-Soldiers' & Sailors' Home and at: www.vets.state.pa.us. Applications are returned to the Dept. of Military Affairs, Division of Veteran's Homes, Fort Indiantown Gap, Annville, PA 17003. Applications are processed in date order of receipt.
