The Department of Health and Human Services, Veterans' Homes Division is looking for a System Financial Analyst who will play a critical role in developing and driving the strategic financial input plans for the Veterans' Homes Division statewide. The incumbent will be responsible for budgetary planning and cost management. Work with Veterans' Homes Administrators and the Veterans' Homes Division Financial staff statewide to assist in the control and management of financial operations. Travel to all Nebraska Veterans' Homes will be required.

Duties include:

- Provide timely and accurate financial information to executive leadership and make actionable recommendations on both strategy and financial operations.
- Able to lead the implementation of strategic initiatives.
- Review, audit and recommend changes to budget and fiscal procedures.
- Analysis of financial management and business practices.
- Provide fiscal strategies to facility management regarding licensure, survey and accreditation.
- Analyze the financial reports and explain variances against the budget.
- Coordinate with program managers to determine appropriate resolution.
- Assist facilities in developing appropriate financial management programs, policies and procedures.
- Research and draft legislation and prepare fiscal notes, provide fiscal impact data for all legislations affecting the division.
- Perform contract analysis.
- Maintain current knowledge of applicable State & Federal regulations impacting the Veterans Homes.
- Monitor legislation introduced impacting the division and provide recommendations.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in Accounting, Finance, Healthcare Management or Healthcare Financial certification (CMPE) and experience in financial analysis, budgeting and forecasting.
- Prefer: Experience in Health Care Revenue Cycle Management. Prior experience with the U.S. Veteran's Affairs Administration a plus. CPA/ Masters Degree in Accounting/ Finance/ Business Management.
- Other: Require valid driver's license or the ability to provide independent authorized transportation.
