***The Facility***

The new Arizona State Veteran Home - Tucson represents Arizona's commitment to provide personalized rehabilitative and restorative long term health care services to Arizona's disabled veterans, their spouses and the parents of those veterans who gave their lives in service to our country. Its mission is to provide these services in a safe, clean, homelike environment, focusing on enhanced health care and quality of life and, thereby, allowing each resident to optimize his/her individual potential.

The 120-bed facility is scheduled to open in the Fall of 2011 and is located adjacent to the campus of the Southern Arizona VA Health Care System. In a shift away from the medical model nursing home and its institutional setting, the facility will provide person-centered care in a homelike environment. In keeping with the community living concept, the resident population will be composed of small communities or neighborhoods where each individual's long-term needs can be met in a way that preserves his/her dignity and independence.

***The Responsibilities & Requirements***

This position is responsible for the leadership, financial management and oversight of a multi-disciplinary Medicare certified nursing facility. Ensures that the Home's resources are used effectively and efficiently to attain or maintain the highest practicable physical, mental and psychological well-being of each resident. Participates in the development and implementation of goals, objectives, programs, projects, policies and procedures related to the operation of the facility. Enforces department and facility policies and ensures compliance with all regulatory requirements. Works to build collaborative and cooperative relationships with federal and state agencies, Veterans Service Organizations and other community service groups.
